

Portfolio Task 1: Commented Bibliography

Start looking for a research topic for your own corpus project by researching recent literature. Identify an area of research that seems interesting for your project. Find at least three journal articles in this area (or close to it), whose methodology is clearly identified as corpus linguistics. List them in a full bibliography in either Harvard or APA style.

Then read the articles and comment critically on each below its bibliography entry. The comment can be marked by brackets () or by indenting the text. It should include a note on the selected corpus/corpora, the focus of their analysis, the method, as well as on one point you take away from this article. You can add remarks on their findings, their theoretical background, their approach, or even on elements that you are critical of or find particularly interesting. Feel free to add anything you deem important when engaging with this article.

Lastly, please add a header to your bibliography. It should include your name, the name of the course, the title *Portfolio Task 1*, your matriculation number and the date of handing in.

Make sure your bibliography

- Features at least three journal articles,
- Does not exceed one page,
- Has a comment on each entry,
- Is in Harvard or APA style,
- Has a header,
